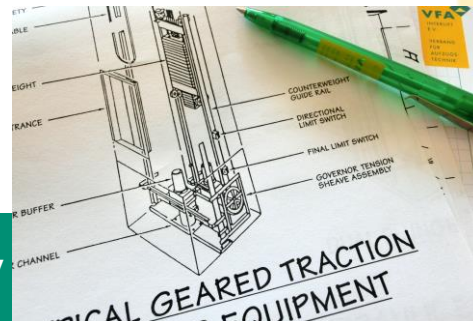

English is increasingly needed for communication. As the lift sector is no exception, the new VFA Academy offer takes account of this fact. The contents of the 'Technical English' course largely corresponds to that of the A1 Basic Course (as specified by VDI 2168), which examines the topic areas of safety, mechanics, electrical engineering, and system appraisal. This means that participants will learn about every principle of the entire 'lift' product, in terms of content as well as (English) terminology. Numerous exhibits will also bring the topic to life.

The course lasts for two and a half days, and participants will receive an English version of the compendium of basic principles from the A1 Basic Course, a reference book of technical English, as well as a German-English / English-German lift dictionary. The lecturers will convey their respective specialist knowledge to participants in English.

Target groups:

Anyone who works in the following areas of the lift sector: sales, planning, development, construction, documentation and people employed by inspection agencies whose area of work – in their own country as well as abroad – means they must be able to communicate competently in English. Previous attendance at a German-speaking A1/VDI 2168 Basic Course is advisable for anyone from this group who would like to participate.

Any English-speaking employee from the lift sector whose work requires them to be familiar with the fundamental principles of lift technology as well as the corresponding regulations.

Participation in this course is documented by means of a Certificate of Attendance. Please note, that, on its own, this does not entitle people to take part in a more advanced German-speaking course, namely A2/VDI 2168.
